That one of these Trustees is bought on to the trust immediately and the second as required.</li> <li>The Omapere Taraire E &amp; Rangihamama X3A Ahu Whenua Trust continues with the planned development and construction of Papakainga housing on this whenua and a meeting will be called within 1 month of the SGM</li> <li>Concerns were expressed by Te Aroha Reihana Ruka regarding the performance of present Trustee's and whether an increase in Trustee numbers is warranted given two Trustees not living in North</li> <li>Chairman assured meeting that all Trustee portfolio holders are very active within their respective roles. Colleen is present at all Board meetings via Skype. The matter of the illegal occupation of land owned by the Trust, although reported on comprehensively within the Chairs Report, was discussed as a separate issue altogether Fletcher Tahere wanted recorded that he objected to this resolution being put to the meeting as they had not prepared their Whanau evidence to present to this hui. Fletcher stated that because the matter was before the court, he was reluctant to talk about it. Fletcher challenged some of the chronology timelines and

- The chair replied that this issue had been going on for some twenty years and needed to be sorted out. Chair reiterated the generous offer from the Trust to the Tahere Whanau of over 110 acres offered to them for their exclusive use, which had been turned down by the Tahere Whanau.
- The Chair also invited the Tahere Whanau to call a meeting of their own so people could turn out and listen to their views.
- All shareholders and Beneficiaries present continue to support the Trust Boards decision regarding the Tahere situation.
